**MAPLE VALLEY FOOD BANK .....425-432-8139**

Mon, Wed, Thur. 10:30am - 1:00pm & 2nd Thurs of the month 5:30 - 7:00 pm. Serves Tahoma School District area, Covington, Black Diamond. Must have Past Due or Disconnect Notice. Amount varies, funds not always available.

**AUBURN FOOD BANK.....253-833-8925**

Mon, Tues, Thur, Fri. 9:00am - 1:15pm & 2<sup>nd</sup> Wed. of the month 4:30-6:30pm. Serves Auburn School District boundaries. Must have Disconnect Notice, amount varies. Appointments made on the food bank's last working day of the month. No phone appointments will be made.

**KENT FOOD BANK.....253-520-3550**

Mon, Tues, Wed, Fri. 10:00am – 2:00pm. Serves Kent School District area. Must call for an appointment - no walk-ins. Maximum \$30 available in a 12- month period.

**BLACK DIAMOND COMMUNITY CENTER .....360-886-1011**

Mon. – Fri. 8:00am – 4:30pm. Serves Black Diamond, Ravensdale, Maple Valley, Covington, Enumclaw. Offers vouchers through Salvation Army for electricity, gas, gasoline, rent and other essentials. Available to low-income families with children, disabled individuals & seniors. Also emergency food bank, clothing bank & Meals on Wheels.

Mon. – Fri. 9:00am – 5:00pm. Covington, Black Diamond, Maple Valley. Pledges for utilities or other financial needs, amount varies. By appointment only, may take up to 48hrs.

**ST. VINCENT de PAUL.....206-767-6449**

Boundaries for areas of help - West: Benson (104<sup>th</sup> SW) to East: Witte Road, North: SE 208<sup>th</sup>, South: SE 320<sup>th</sup>. Amount varies, responses limited to 8 calls per week.

**ST. JAMES CHURCH OUTREACH.....253-852-4100**

Call between 9:00am – 12:00pm, Mon. - Thurs. for an appointment. Serves Kent zip code area, must have disconnect notice. Amount varies, once per year \$35 - \$40.

**KENT UNITED METHODIST CHURCH.....253-852-3900**

Serves Kent school district only. Minimum pledge \$50.00. Must have Disconnect Notice or Eviction Notice. **NOTE: Pledges for power or rent only.**

**FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH.....253-852-3370**

Mon. – Fri. 9:00am – 1:00pm call for appointment. Serves the Kent zip code area. Must have a Disconnect Notice. **NOTE: Pledges for power only.**
