No rate increases for the second year

in a row. CWD is focused on fiscal responsibility and sustainability. CWD's cash on hand is at \$22.6M and debt ratio has been reduced to 41%. Water service revenue was 12.8% higher than budgeted for in 2017.



Compliant with regulatory

requirements. CWD received a clean audit from the State Auditor's Office for fiscal year 2016. CWD met/exceeded all regulatory DOH requirements related to drinking water quality and safety.



Relationships with community partners.

CWD actively participates, meets with and supports regional partners/causes. CWD staff volunteers at Covington Days, Maple Valley Emergency Preparedness Fair, the Covington Chamber Community Expo and more.



Children are the future. CWD makes time to educate youth about water, CWD's role in the community, and future career opportunities within the field. CWD participates in STEAM expos at elementary schools and supports the Play Unplugged as a sponsor.



Reliable and safe infrastructure. CWD has been awarded a \$79,000 grant to fund the production of energy from the new Tacoma Water C-4 turnout, transmission main and turbine building project. CWD has also invested in Asset Management and GIS software improvements.
